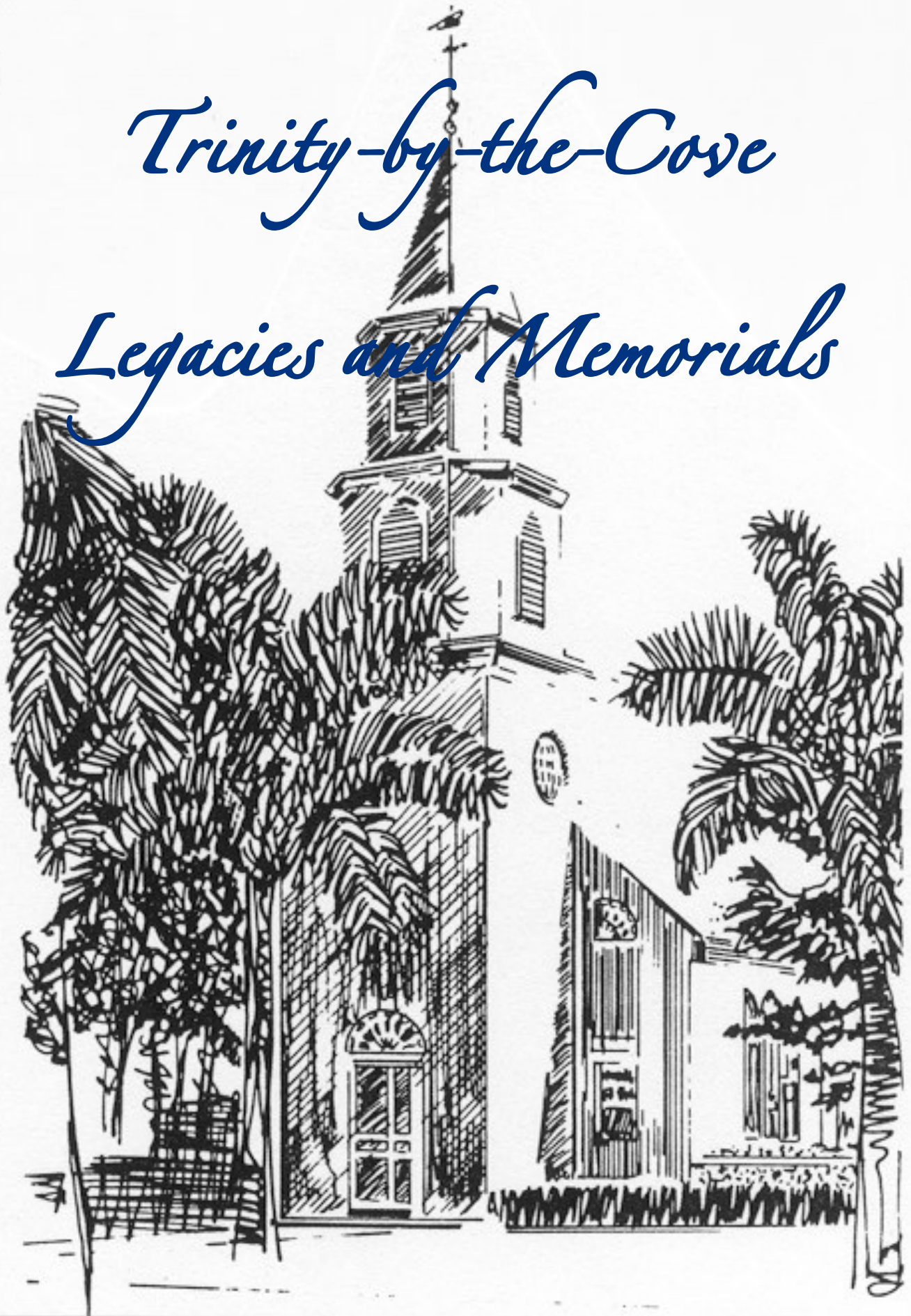

friendship and service to others.*

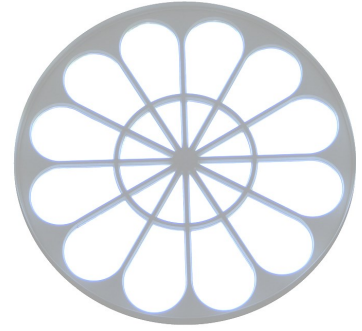

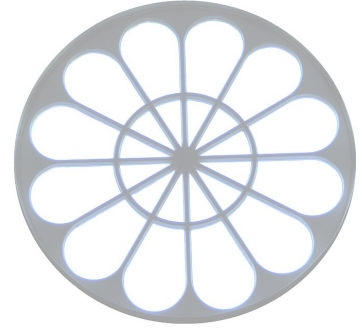

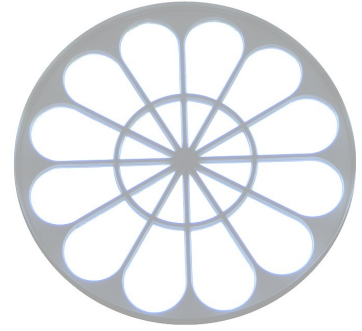
